




How to Change your Password on the MacBook Pro

Once you start getting notices to change your password, please do so. Don't wait until you have 0 days left as this will cause problems.

1. Go to the triangle with the checkmark on the menu bar at the top. 
2. Click and pull down to Change Password.
3. Enter your current password, new password and verify the password.
4. Click Change
5. If it doesn't successfully change, restart your computer and go back to #1.
6. Once your password is successfully changed, go to the Wifi icon on the menu bar and pull down to Open Network Preferences. 
7. On the left side highlight Wi-Fi.
8. On the lower right side click on the Advanced button.
9. In the WiFi window highlight FHSD-WiFi and click the minus sign below to delete it.
10. Click OK.
11. Click Apply.
12. In the upper right side, click Turn Wi-Fi Off.
13. Click Turn Wi-Fi On.
14. Go back up to the WiFi icon in the menu bar and pull down to FHSD-WiFi. 
15. Enter your credentials.
16. From here you can update any/all passwords for mail, IC, OneDrive, Google, etc.
